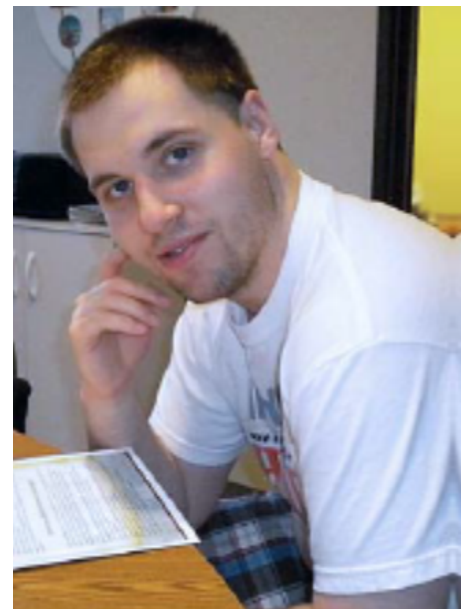
Designed to occur in the home, school, workplace, or other locations within the community, our Cognitive Rehabilitation model allows for skill development in a variety of community environments.
